

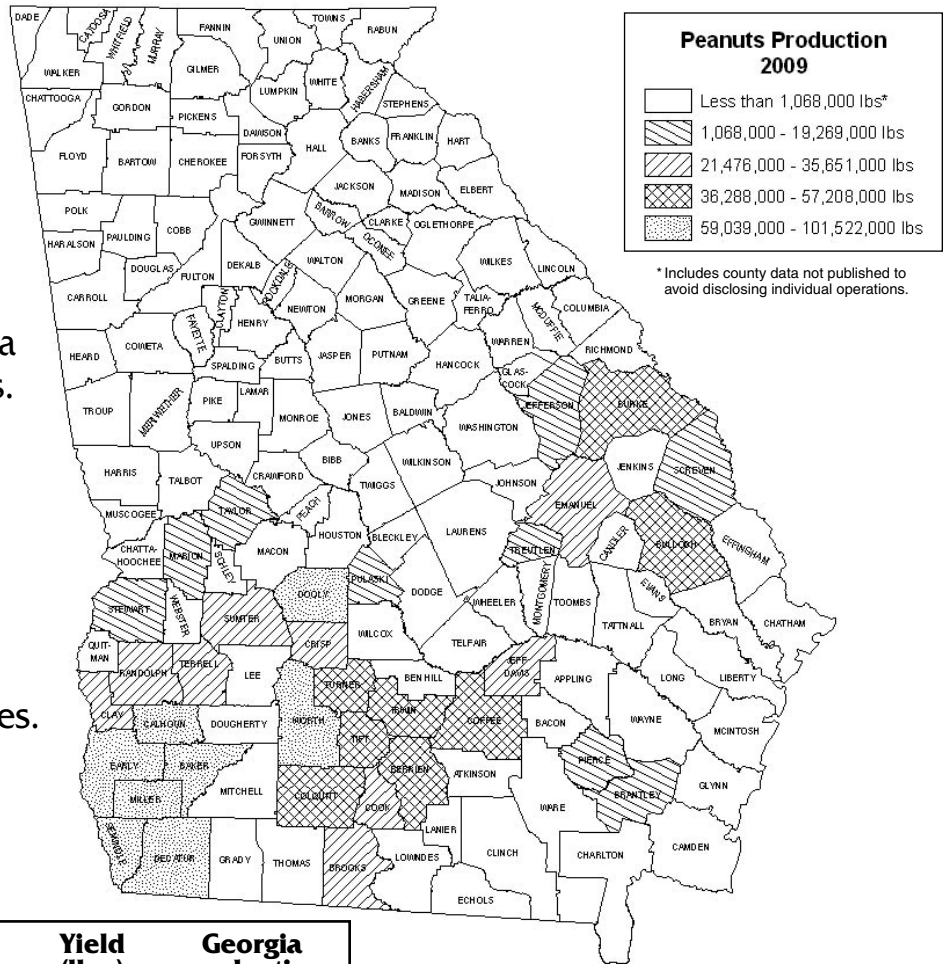

Did you know:

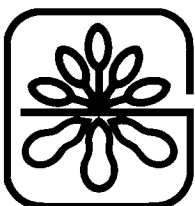
- ◆ Georgia produces 49% of the United States' peanuts.
- ◆ About 70 counties in Georgia produced 1,782,650,000 lbs. of peanuts in 2009.
- ◆ Georgia has approximately 14,000 farms with peanuts and about 4,500 active farmers.
- ◆ Georgia has approximately 200 peanut related businesses.
- ◆ The peanut industry contributes about 50,000 jobs in Georgia.
