



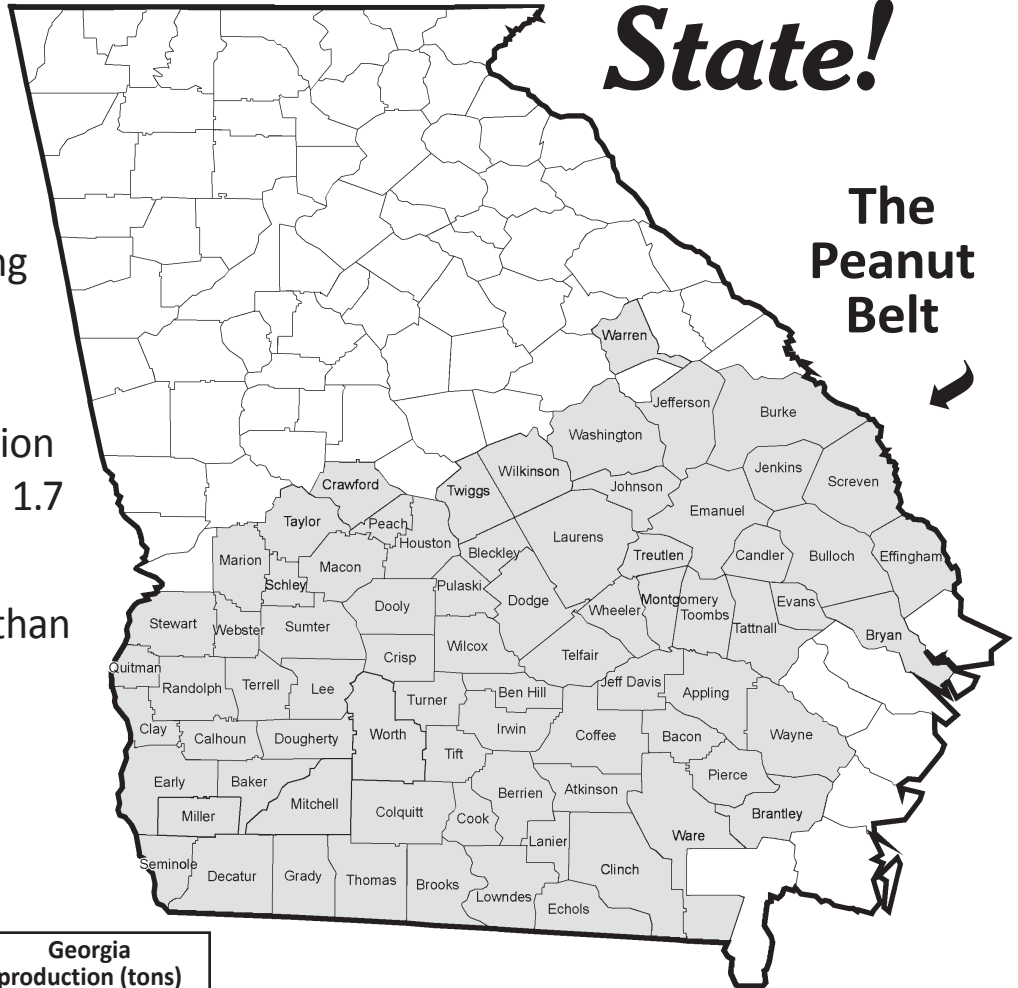


2015 Georgia... *the Peanut State!*

In 2015, Georgia peanuts:

-  Were planted on 785,000 acres, yielding an average of 4,470 pounds per acre, leading in the U.S.
-  Accounted for almost 56% of peanut production in the U.S. – more than 1.7 million tons.
-  Were planted in more than 75 of 159 counties.
-  Were grown by approximately 3,400 peanut farmers.
