



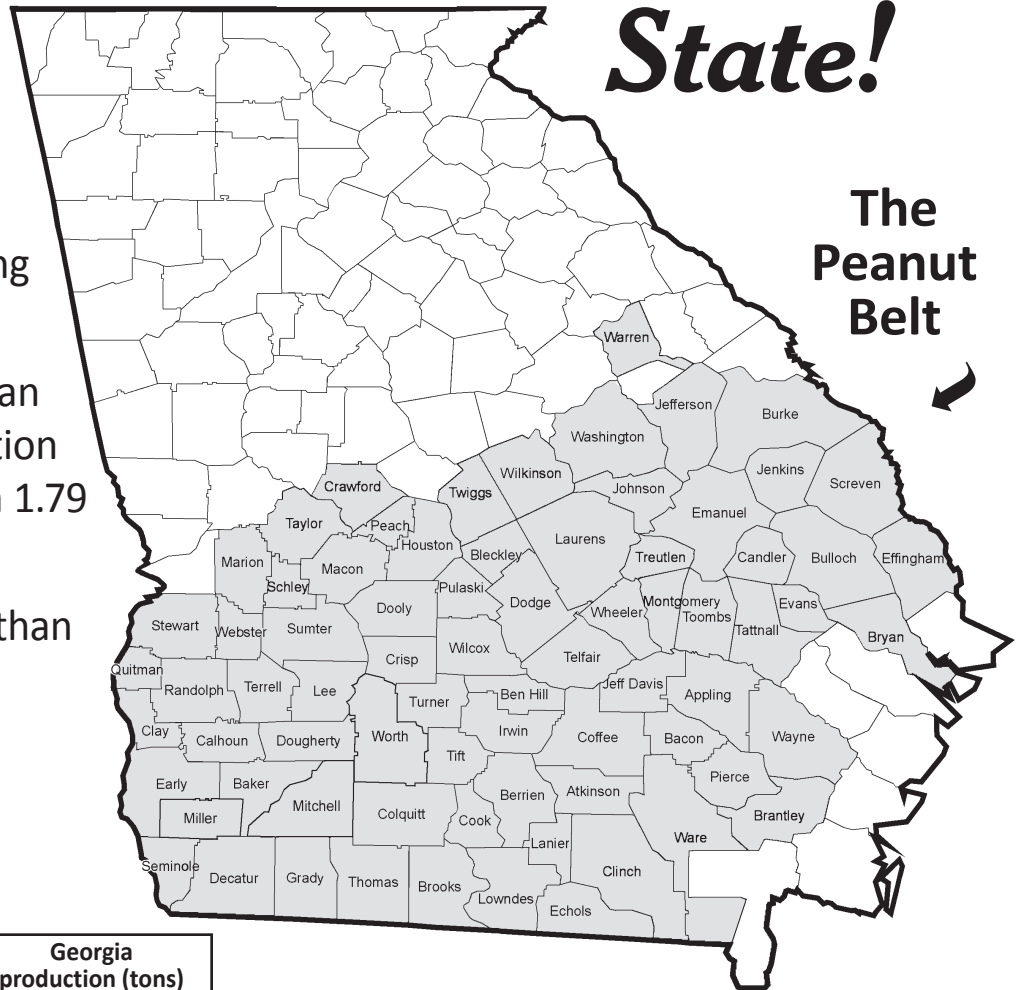


2017 Georgia... *the Peanut State!*

In 2017, Georgia peanuts:

-  Were harvested on 825,000 acres, yielding an average of 4,353 pounds per acre, leading in the U.S.
-  Accounted for more than 50% of peanut production in the U.S. – more than 1.79 million tons.
-  Were planted in more than 75 of 159 counties.
-  Were grown by approximately 4,700 peanut farmers.
