



Changes for the 2014 Georgia Peanut Farm Show that could affect you:

- **Exhibit space price increase** – You can see in the exhibitor folder that we have increased the prices on exhibit spaces, and for the first time we have added a third category for exhibit space size choices. We anticipate feeding three to four hundred or more participants as last year which costs at least an additional \$5,000. We are also facing significant increases in postage and printing charges for another \$5,000 increase in cost. With these modest price increases, the first in nearly 15 years, the space for the show is still very competitive and a good buy compared to any other agricultural show known. This is also in part due to a new system that the Georgia Peanut Commission's Farm Show Committee wishes to test for dealing with door prizes.
- **Door Prize changes** – We will no longer be asking for door prize submissions other than the Grand Door Prize and Grower Prize. Instead, we will be using some of the increase in the exhibit space rentals to purchase more door prizes that are similar in value; however, we do not want to discourage exhibitors from still bringing a door prize if they wish to do so. The process will be a little different from previous years. If you have a door prize, we will announce the winner from our main stage, but you will be responsible for the drawing at your booth or prearranged to come and draw from our turn-drum. Either way, you bring us only a booth/exhibitor name and the name of the winner. You will keep possession of the door prize so that the winner can pick it up straight from your booth. We will distribute no door prizes.
- **Shorter show by 2 and half hours** – The show will be ending at 2:30 p.m. this year instead of 5:00 p.m. The Farm Show Committee has decided that decreasing the length of the show will be better overall for participants and exhibitors alike. This will include hosting the awards ceremony in the ball rooms (main lunch area) while participants are eating (a feed will be streamed live to both the large and small auditoriums), as well as moving the Grand Door Prize drawing to 2 p.m.
- **Large equipment exhibits** – The size of the large equipment exhibits are 16 feet deep by 20 feet wide. Please make sure that the equipment you bring will fit in this area. If it will not, then you will need to buy the appropriate number of spaces in order for the equipment to fit. The size of the door that the equipment will have to fit through is 16 feet tall by 19½ feet wide.
